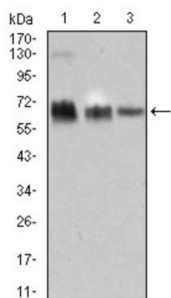
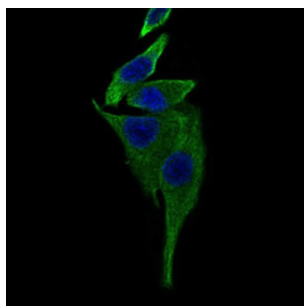

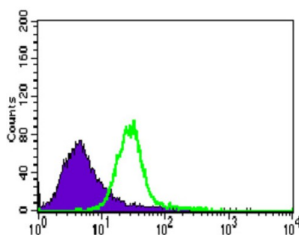

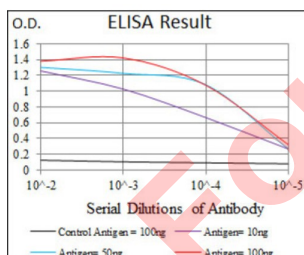
Western blot analysis using TRAFD1 antibody against human TRAFD1 recombinant protein. (Expected MW is 45 kDa).
