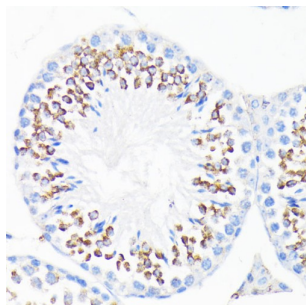
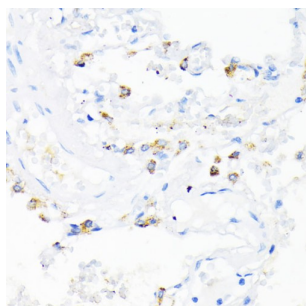

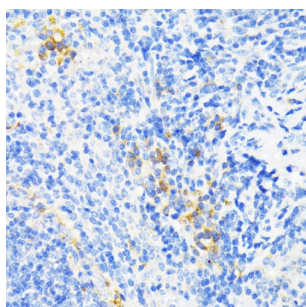

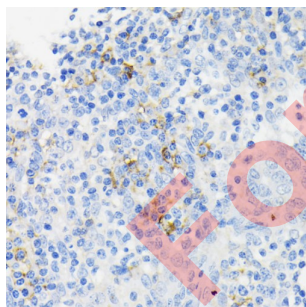
Immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded Mouse testis using CAMP Antibody (1/200 dilution, 40x lens).

CAMP Antibody is a Rabbit Polyclonal antibody against CAMP. This gene encodes a member of an antimicrobial peptide family, characterized by a highly conserved N-terminal signal peptide containing a cathelin domain and a structurally variable cationic antimicrobial peptide, which is produced by extracellular proteolysis from the C-terminus. The encoded protein has several functions in addition to antimicrobial activity, including cell chemotaxis, immune mediator induction and inflammatory response regulation.
