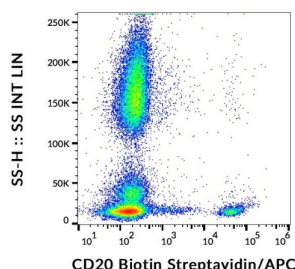

Buffer: PBS solution with 15 mM sodium azide.

Specificity: The antibody reacts with CD20 (Bp35), a 33-37 kDa non-glycosylated membrane receptor with four transmembrane domains, expressed on B lymphocytes (it is lost on plasma cells), follicular dendritic cells, and at low levels on peripheral blood T lymphocytes.

Concentration: 1 mg/ml
