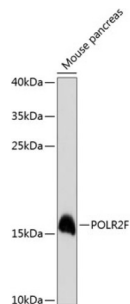


RNA Polymerase II Subunit F (POLR2F) Antibody

POLR2F Antibody is a Rabbit Polyclonal antibody against POLR2F. This gene encodes the sixth largest subunit of RNA polymerase II, the polymerase responsible for synthesizing messenger RNA in eukaryotes. In yeast, this polymerase subunit, in combination with at least two other subunits, forms a structure that stabilizes the transcribing polymerase on the DNA template. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.
