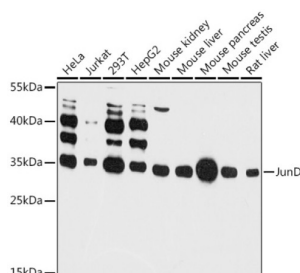


## Transcription Factor JunD (JUND) Antibody
