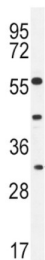
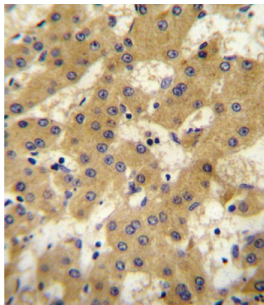


Apolipoprotein F (APOF) Antibody
