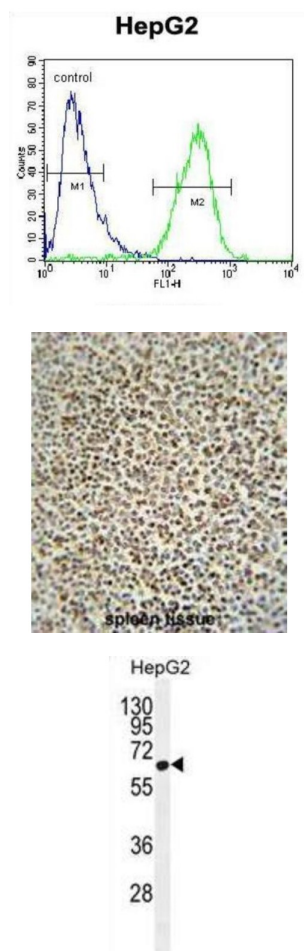


Zinc Finger CCCH Domain-Containing Protein 12A (ZC12A) Antibody

ZC12A is an MCP1 (CCL2; MIM 158105) induced protein that acts as a transcriptional activator and causes cell death of cardiomyocytes, possibly via induction of genes associated with apoptosis.
