TRIM56 belongs to the TRIM/RBCC family. It contains 2 B box-type zinc fingers and a RING-type zinc finger. There are 3 named isoforms produced by alternative splicing.

Purification: Purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
