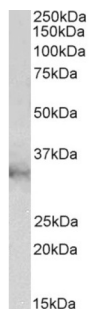
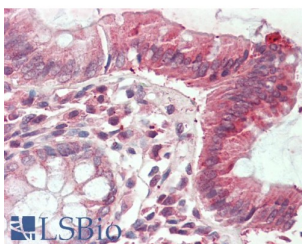


Chloride Intracellular Channel Protein 1 (CLIC1) Antibody
