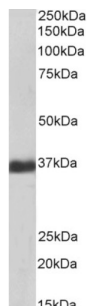


Glyceraldehyde-3-Phosphate Dehydrogenase (GAPDH) Antibody (Biotin)

Western blot analysis of Human Liver lysate (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer) using biotin-conjugated Glyceraldehyde-3-Phosphate Dehydrogenase (GAPDH) Antibody (1 µg/ml, 1 hour). Detected by chemiluminescence, using streptavidin-HRP and using NAP blocker as a substitute for skimmed milk.

GAPDH Antibody is a Goat Polyclonal antibody against GAPDH ([abx431279](#)) conjugated to biotin.
