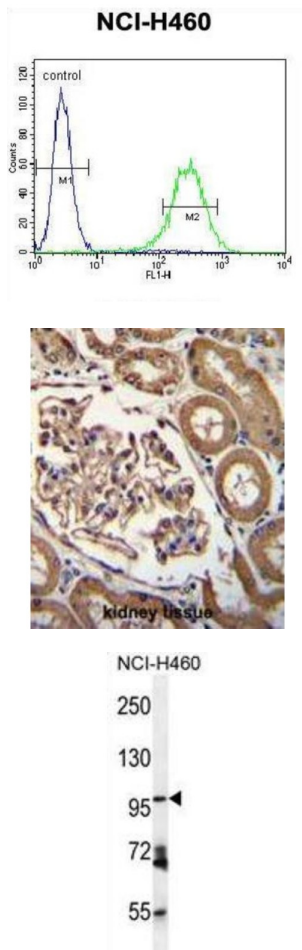


Glutamyl Aminopeptidase (Aminopeptidase A) (ENPEP) Antibody
