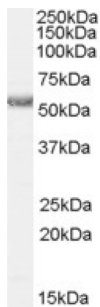
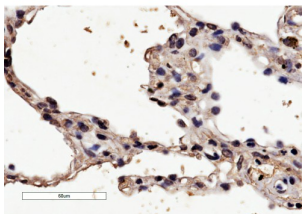


Histamine Receptor H1 (HRH1) Antibody
