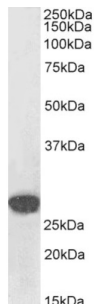

Western blot analysis of A431 lysate (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer) using biotin-conjugated Snail Family Transcriptional Repressor 1 / SNAIL (SNAI1) Antibody (0.1 µg/ml, 1 hour). Detected by chemiluminescence, using streptavidin-HRP and using NAP blocker as a substitute for skimmed milk.

SNAI1 Antibody is a Goat Polyclonal antibody against SNAI1 ([abx430958](#)) conjugated to biotin.
