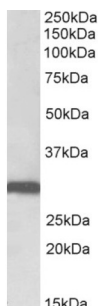
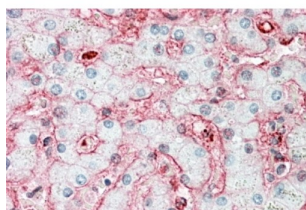


Stomatin (STOM) Antibody
