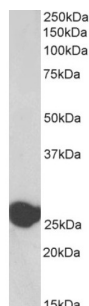


Triosephosphate isomerase Antibody (Biotin)

Western blot analysis of Human Liver lysate (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer) using biotin-conjugated Triosephosphate isomerase Antibody (0.03 µg/ml, 1 hour). Detected by chemiluminescence, using streptavidin-HRP and using NAP blocker as a substitute for skimmed milk.

Triosephosphate isomerase Antibody is a Goat Polyclonal antibody against Triosephosphate isomerase ([abx431681](#)) conjugated to biotin.

Target: Triosephosphate isomerase

Recommended dilutions: P-ELISA: 1/16000. Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Form: Liquid

Purification: Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
