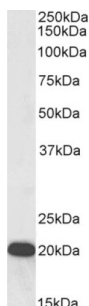


Ubiquitously Expressed Transcript Protein (UXT) Antibody (Biotin)

Western blot analysis of Human Kidney lysate (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer) using biotin-conjugated Ubiquitously Expressed Transcript Protein (UXT) Antibody (0.3 µg/ml, 1 hour). Detected by chemiluminescence, using streptavidin-HRP and using NAP blocker as a substitute for skimmed milk.

UXT Antibody is a Goat Polyclonal antibody against UXT ([abx433436](#)) conjugated to biotin.

Purification:	Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.
Storage:	Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
