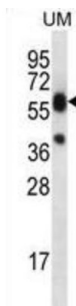
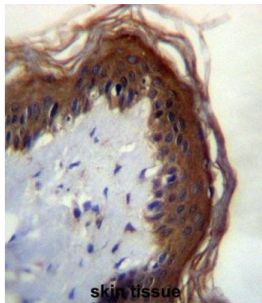


Lipase Member M (LIPM) Antibody
