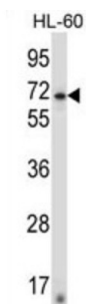


Zinc Finger Protein 415 (ZNF415) Antibody

ZNF415 is involved in transcriptional regulation. Transcriptional activity differed among the various isoforms. All isoforms except isoform 3 seem to suppress the transcriptional activities of AP-1 and TP53/p53.

Purification: Purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
