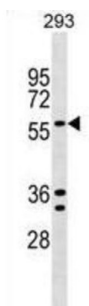


TRAF-Type Zinc Finger Domain Containing 1 (TRAFD1) Antibody

Storage:	Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
