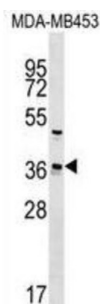


Ubiquitin Conjugating Enzyme E2 Z (UBE2Z) Antibody

Modification of proteins with ubiquitin (UBB; MIM 191339) or ubiquitin-like proteins controls many signaling networks and requires a ubiquitin activating enzyme (E1), a ubiquitin conjugating enzyme (E2), and a ubiquitin protein ligase (E3). UBE2Z is an E2 enzyme (Jin et al., 2007 [PubMed 17597759]). [supplied by OMIM].

Target: Ubiquitin Conjugating Enzyme E2 Z (UBE2Z)

Clonality: Polyclonal

Recommended dilutions: WB: 1/1000. Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide between 284-310 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human UBE2Z.

Isotype: IgG

Form: Liquid

Purification: Purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
