Immunogen: Rabbit IgG

Form: Liquid

Purification: The antibody was affinity-purified from goat antiserum by affinity-chromatography using specific immunogen.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Buffer: PBS, containing 50% glycerol, 0.5% BSA and 0.02% sodium azide.
