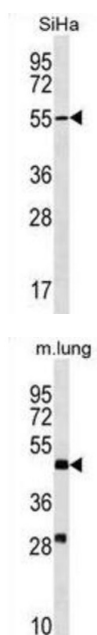


Ring Finger Protein 150 (RNF150) Antibody
