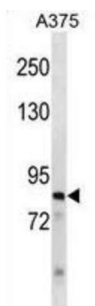


Zinc Finger Protein 148 (ZNF148) Antibody

ZNF148 is involved in transcriptional regulation. Represses the transcription of a number of genes including gastrin, stromelysin and enolase. Binds to the G-rich box in the enhancer region of these genes.

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide between 106-135 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human ZNF148.

Form: Liquid

Purification: Purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
