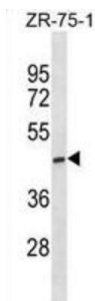


Alpha-N-Acetylgalactosaminide Alpha-2,6-Sialyltransferase 5 (ST6GALNAC5) Antibody

ST6GALNAC5 belongs to a family of sialyltransferases that modify proteins and ceramides on the cell surface to alter cell-cell or cell-extracellular matrix interactions (Tsuchida et al., 2003 [PubMed 12668675]).

Storage:	Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
