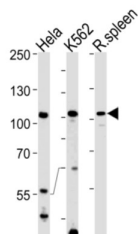


Tuftelin-Interacting Protein 11 (TFIP11) Antibody

TFIP11 is a nuclear speckle-localized protein that may play a role in spliceosome disassembly in Cajal bodies (Stanek et al., 2008 [PubMed 18367544]).

Storage:	Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
