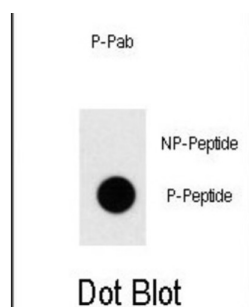


TAL1 (pT90) Antibody

TAL1 is implicated in the genesis of hemopoietic malignancies. It may play an important role in hemopoietic differentiation and serves as a positive regulator of erythroid differentiation.

Storage:	Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
