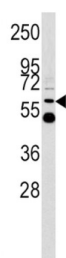
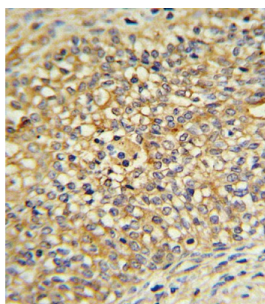


UDP-Glucuronosyltransferase 2B17 (UGB17) Antibody
