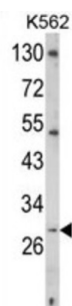
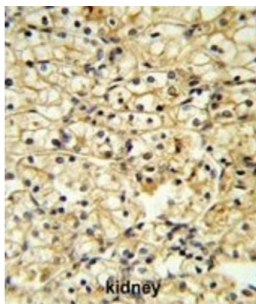
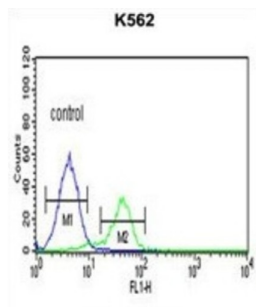


TNF-Related Activation Protein (TRAP) Antibody
