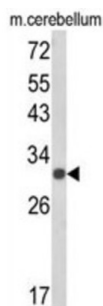
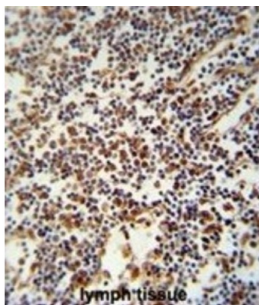


Upstream Stimulatory Factor 2 (USF2) Antibody
