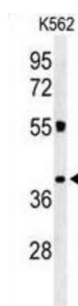
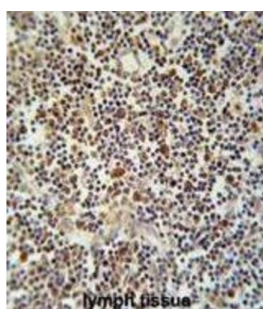
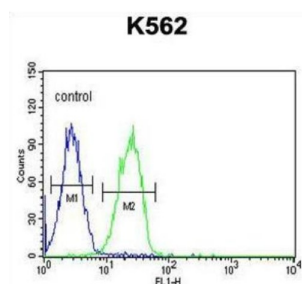


CMRF35-Like Molecule 1 (CLM1) Antibody
