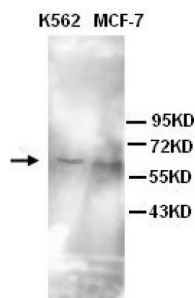
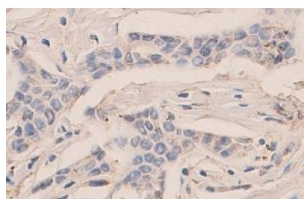


Asparagine Synthetase (ASNS) Antibody
