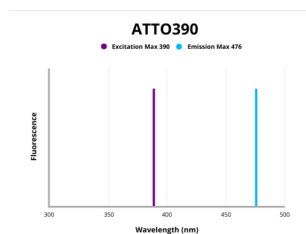

Immunogen:	Phosphoserine conjugated to KLH, and phosvitin mixture
Purification:	Peptide Affinity Purified
Storage:	Store at 4 °C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
Buffer:	581 mM DMSO, 123 mM Ethanolamine, 9.44 mM PBS, 9.1 mM Sodium Bicarbonate.
Specificity:	Detects proteins phosphorylated on serine residues. Does not cross-react with phosphotyrosine.
Concentration:	0.25 mg/ml
