If a higher concentration is required, the product can be reconstituted directly in PBS, pH 7.4, though please note that this will change the overall salt concentration. The stock concentration should be between 0.1-1.0 mg/ml. Do not vortex.
Storage:	Store at 2-8°C for up to one month. For long-term storage, store at -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
