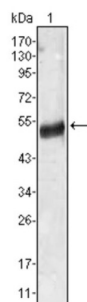


Angiotensinogen (AGT) Antibody

Western blot analysis using AGT antibody against human plasma (1).

AGT, pre-angiotensinogen or angiotensinogen precursor, is expressed in the liver and is cleaved by the enzyme renin in response to lowered blood pressure. The resulting product, angiotensin I, is then cleaved by angiotensin converting enzyme (ACE) to generate the physiologically active enzyme angiotensin II.

Immunogen:	Purified recombinant fragment of human AGT expressed in E. coli.

Form:	Liquid
Purification:	Unpurified ascites.
Storage:	Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
